SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

Supervisor Peterson reported to the Board:

- A. The Township will meet with the Village of Buffalo Grove Police Department to authorize the Township's representative to enforce the parking fee regulations at the train station.
- B. He met with Mr. Hansen, owner of the Prairie House Restaurant and told him the Village of Buffalo Grove is reluctant to dedicate a special use district for one property as it will be too costly. Mr. Hansen suggested he pay a portion of the cost. Mr. Peterson will continue to review costs and a possible resolution. He will keep the Board informed.
- C. The social agency requests for funding has commenced. Omni Youth Services will attend the Feb. meeting.
- D. A letter has been mailed to Illinois federal legislators urging them to implement federal revenue sharing funds in their proposed budget.
