New Township to Resident Notification System

We are pleased to announce that Vernon Township has recently implemented a new township-to-resident notification system through Blackboard Connect. With this service, the township can send personalized messages to the unincorporated residents of the township within minutes with specific information about time-sensitive or common interest issues such as emergencies and local community events.

The Blackboard Connect system allows the township to send critical information and updates to thousands of recipients in just minutes with the click of a button-via home phone, cell phones, text message, and e-mails. Should a situation arise that only affects certain streets or neighborhoods we have the capability through the Blackboard Connect system to notify only those residents.

In order to contact the unincorporated residents that have unlisted or unpublished phone numbers, or to send a message via a different route such as; a cell phone, text or e-mail we need your help. Please visit our website at www.vernontownship.com to register and update your contact information. If you do not have access to the internet you may contact the township office at (847) 634-4600 and we will assist you in the registration process.

Messages from Vernon Township will only be sent to unincorporated residents of the township. Many of the villages within the township have a similar notification system; please contact your local village for more information.

Be assured that all personal information we receive is considered confidential and will be treated as such. All information is stored in the Blackboard Connect database system and will not be shared with a third party.

HealthReach Clinic

HealthReach Clinic offers **medical visits, dental and vision** care for qualifying Lake County residents. This free clinic serves the medically uninsured, low income families of Lake County. Patients must have an income level of no more than 150% (\$16,245.00 for a single person, \$21,855.00 for 2 in the family and up in increments with the number of family members) above the federal poverty line and provide the information below:

- The most recent check stubs, unemployment stubs, or any other form of income
- 2008 tax return and after April 30 they will need the 2009 return
- Photo ID
- Medicaid denial letter from the Public Aid Office
- Proof of Lake County residency (electric bill, phone bill, etc.)

Although HealthReach serves everyone free of charge, they do ask for a donation at each visit as they do not receive any state or federal funding.

HealthReach has recently implemented Acute Care (sick call) for their registered patients, but has limited hours. For further information on the days and hours please call (847) 360-8800.

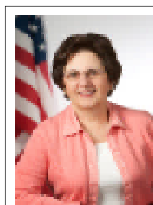

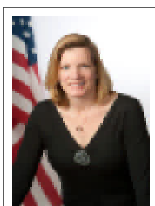

Clerk's Corner

Vernon Township Cemeteries

The Vernon Township Cemetery is located in Lincolnshire at the corner of Highway 45 and Milwaukee Ave. (behind strip mall). Grave sites and mausoleum spaces are available for purchase. The mausoleum contains 64 crypts, and 24 columbarium niches. Each individual crypt or niche can be personalized on the front at your discretion.

Vernon Township is selling the crypts for \$5,000 each and a niche for \$700. If you are interested in purchasing either a crypt or niche please call (847) 634-4600 and ask for Barbara Barnabee.

The Township also has grave sites available for purchase at Diamond Lake Cemetery in Mundelein. Diamond Lake Cemetery is located on the south side of Route 60 west of Butterfield Road.



Cemetery Clean Up

Each spring during the months of March and April, Vernon Township cleans up the cemetery grounds and prepares for the summer months. If you wish to save your winter decorations at either Vernon or Diamond Lake Cemeteries please remove them by the end of April. As of May 1 all remaining winter decorations will be removed and disposed of.

Fishing and Hunting Licenses

Cash Dash

Electronics Recycling Event and Food Drive

For the 2010 Spring Electronic Recycling event we have added non-perishable food to the items we will be collecting. We average 13 tons of electronics per collection event, so filling a one ton truck with non-perishable food should be easy. The food collected will be used to help feed the less fortunate families within Vernon Township.

Personal Computers, Monitors, Computer Drives, Keyboards, Modems, Mainframes, Scanners, Printers, PDA Organizers, Cellular Phones, Televisions, Stereos, MP3 Players, CD Players, DVD Players, VCR's, Cameras, Video Games, Fax Machines, Shredders, and Small Household Appliances

Accepted food items:

Non-perishable, Unopened and Non-expired Food, Toiletries and Paper Products

To participate in the electronic recycling event it is not mandatory to donate food, but it would be greatly appreciated by the township and its less fortunate residents. On the other hand; to donate food does not require you to bring electronics to recycle. So please help us to meet our goals of keeping hazardous materials that are stored in electronics out of the landfills and to stock the township food pantry with much needed food.

The event will occur on Friday, May 14 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Vernon Township 3050 N. Main St., Buffalo Grove.

Culvert Maintenance

Keeping the culverts in front of your home free of debris is important for proper drainage. A periodic check of your culverts and removal of any debris can alleviate flooding problems during the rainy season. If you are a resident of unincorporated Vernon Township and are having difficulty removing any debris or you find a plugged culvert, call the highway department at (847) 634-4600.

Clarke Mosquito Abatement

As the weather gets warmer the emergence of mosquitoes begins. To help eliminate this continued threat, Vernon Township has again contracted with Clarke Mosquito Control to treat known areas in *unincorporated* Vernon Township. For further information regarding this program or if you are having problems with mosquitoes near your home please call the Mosquito hotline at 1 (800) 942-2555. If you do not live in an unincorporated area, please contact the village you live in regarding their abatement program.

Spring Clean-up Weekend

This year's Spring Clean-up weekend in the areas of unincorporated Vernon Township will occur on Saturday, May 1 and Sunday, May 2 with rain dates on May 8 and May 9.

When discarding items into the dumpsters, please take the time to do so in such a way that will allow the maximum use for the space provided. Please refrain from filling the dumpsters over the top. Appliances and tires should be placed alongside the dumpster so that we can dispose of them properly.

Hazardous materials and chemicals are not allowed in or around the dumpsters, contact SWALCO at (847) 336-9340 or on line at www.swalco.org to find out where you can properly dispose of these items. Additional items that are not allowed in the dumpsters are; grass clippings, yard waste and building materials.

Dumpsters will be located in the unincorporated areas of: Horatio Gardens, Krisview Acres, The Meadows, Pekara, Elm Road and on Juneway at Frank Avenue.

The Raupp Report

Good news! The Homestead Limited Exemption for the tax year 2009 payable in 2010 has been increased. This exemption lowers your equalized assessed value by \$6,000 before the tax rate is applied. To figure out the dollar amount you will get off your tax bill, take \$6,000 and multiply it by your tax rate. You can find your rate on your tax bill towards the bottom of the bill. This exemption is for your primary residence and there is no need to apply for it. If you do not see the Homestead Exemption on your tax bill that comes out in May, give our office a call at (847) 634-4602. If you need a copy of your prior tax bill you can get your bill on line by visiting the Lake County's web site at www.lakecountyil.gov. On the right hand side of the site under Quick Links click on "Check Property Tax Payment Status".

The county offers ten property tax exemptions. To get more information about the exemptions that are offered and whether or not you qualify for more than one, visit the Lake County's web site. On the main page, in the search box type in "property tax exemptions" the site will list all ten exemptions. To understand the requirements of each exemption, just click on the title of that exemption and an explanation will be given.

What are the responsibilities of the Vernon Townships Assessor's Office?

It is the responsibility of the assessor and his staff to establish value on your home. Determining property assessments in Illinois is an "ad valorem" process, meaning according to value. Illinois Law 35 ILCS 200/1-55, states that all township assessors are to determine value each year as of January 1st using the sales that accrued from the previous three years on an annual basis. To determine the value of a property our office uses the sales comparison approach. We observe and analyze the selling prices of comparable properties, and make yearly adjustments according to the increase or decrease in sales. We do NOT determine the tax dollar amount that you pay; that is decided by referendums and school budgets. Tax amounts are calculated from the taxing body's annual budgets. 68% of your tax bill is paid to the school districts.

Vernon Township Pool Information

Any person wishing to enjoy the Vernon Township Aquatics Facility must have a valid season pass or purchase a daily pass at the pool registration desk. To be eligible for resident rates, you must provide proof of your Vernon Township residency with a valid driver's license or by a current real estate tax bill. Only those immediate family members and care givers living at your residence will be eligible for family rates. (See guidelines below.)

All season pass holders are required to have a photo identification card, issued by Vernon Township. If you cannot present this card to the pool attendant at the time of check-in, you will be charged the daily user rate.

Through the season, pool pass photos are taken at the Vernon Township Administrative Center, Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. **For your convenience, additional pool pass photo hours are as follows:**

May 3, 2010 to May 22, 2010 (Tentative)
Tuesdays and Thursdays - 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
Saturdays 9:00 a.m. - Noon.



Individuals must be present for their pass photo. We will not take a picture of a photo brought in by another person. Vernon Township will NOT give credit towards the purchase of a pool pass for any daily fees paid.

Pass Guidelines

- Admission to the pool requires payment of a daily admission fee or a pool pass, regardless of age.
- A pool pass must be presented upon check-in at the pool. If you can not present the card at the time of check-in, you will be charged the daily user rate. Lifeguards can not issue pool passes at the pool and will not accept any other form of identification for admission into the pool.
- Pool passes are NOT transferable.
- Passes are not refundable.
- Only immediate family members living in your residence are eligible for family rates. Nannies and live-in baby sitters can be included, but must provide proof of residency at your address. Live out nannies and baby sitters must purchase an individual pass or purchase a daily pass.
- Replacement passes are \$5.00
- All passes are property of Vernon Township and can be suspended or revoked at any time.
- Passes used fraudulently or false information on the registration form may result in all of your family passes being revoked with no refund.
- For purposes of daily fees, adults are those individuals ages 16 and up.
- A responsible adult over the age of 16 must accompany children ages 8 and below.

The above is only a partial list of pool guidelines. Vernon Township has the authority to enforce additional guidelines.
