



Vernon Township Welcomes Newly Appointed Supervisor Tim Kobler

Tim Kobler, who has served as the Vernon Township Clerk since 2021, was sworn into office as the next Township Supervisor at the April Board meeting. Kobler is a 20-year Buffalo Grove resident, and a retired municipal police sergeant whose career in law enforcement spanned 25 years.

As the Township's new leader, Kobler says he will focus on enhancing resident experiences and implementing cost efficiency measures where they are needed throughout the Township. He additionally believes it is crucial that Township residents are aware of and have access to the many services available through the Township – which include the Food Pantry, Emergency Assistance, senior services, as well as sports and recreation opportunities among many others.

Over his career in municipal policing, Kobler received the Law Enforcement Award from the Illinois State Bar Association in 2005, the Valor Award in 2008, he was a four-time recipient

of Meritorious Award for "Going above and beyond the call of duty," in addition to being a recipient of the Fred Bornstein Memorial Coaches Award from the Buffalo Grove Park District in 2014, and the O'Rourke Award from the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council in 2020.



"We were fortunate to have a strong leader in Tim who was willing and ready to serve as our new leader," said

Senior Township Trustee Phil Hirsh. "Tim has shown his dedication to the Township not only in his work as the Township Clerk, but also through his years of volunteer efforts with our Food Pantry."

We are embarking on a journey to replace and update infrastructure that has long surpassed its life expectancy and is no longer cost-effective to maintain. Each project has been carefully considered, with a focus on determining needs and understanding the fiscal impact on our community.

One of the significant projects slated for this year is the replacement of the heating and air conditioning system in the administrative building. We are excited to announce that we will be installing a geothermal system, which offers higher efficiency, lower energy costs throughout the year, and a reduced carbon footprint, all for approximately the same cost as a conventional system. Additionally, our road resurfacing project for this year will focus on the Inverrary subdivision, including culvert repair.

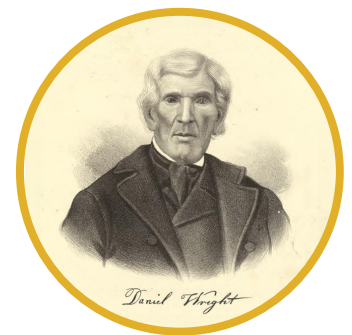
Diamond Lake Cemetery: A Haven of Memories

Tucked away on the south side of Route 60, nestled between Route 45 and Butterfield Road, is Diamond Lake Cemetery. It has been there since 1853, adorned with ancient trees providing solace. Although we are no longer selling grave sites, the cemetery still welcomes families to visit their ancestral plots keeping alive the ties that bind generations.

Vernon Cemetery: A Chronicle of Generations Past

Dating back to 1835, notable figures such as Captain Daniel Wright and members of the Tripp and Sprague families, whose names adorn local schools, rest in the

Vernon Cemetery. It remains an active site, offering grave plots, niches, and crypts to those seeking a final resting place.



Preserving the Sanctity of Memory

In reverence of the memories enshrined within these sacred grounds, seasonal cleanup of decorations occurs around November 1st of each year. To ensure the preservation of personal mementos, visitors are kindly requested to retrieve any items they wish to keep before this date. Any decorations remaining thereafter will be respectfully removed.

Highway Department Update

HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE

If you notice a damaged or missing street or traffic control sign, a dangerous pothole, a burned-out overhead intersection light, or other road hazards in unincorporated Vernon Township, **please report it to Tracy at Vernon Township (847) 634-4600.**

CULVERT MAINTENANCE

Periodically cleaning out the culvert and drainage ditch in front of your property will reduce the chances of flooding and standing water on your property, especially during the rainy season.

PERMITS

If you live in Unincorporated Vernon Township and you plan to perform any work in the right of way in front of your property a permit is required from Vernon Township Highway Department. Such work would include but is not limited to, plantings, culvert-ditch maintenance, and driveway replacement.

The right of way is defined as the area from your property line to the edge of the road. For most homes, this area is approximately 15 feet.

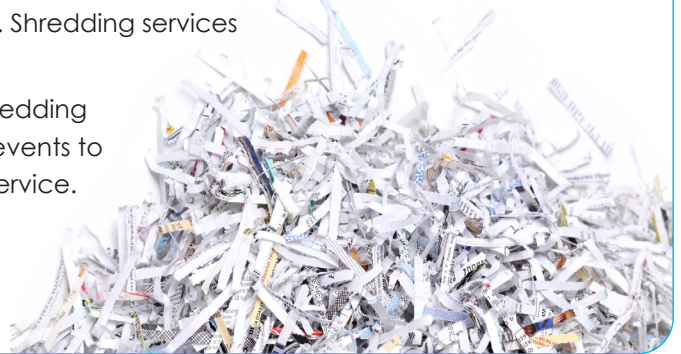

This is an onsite shredding event, however if the truck fills up, there will be locked containers on site where you will be able to safely put your documents. Shredding services will be provided by Opportunity Secure Data Destruction.

In response to the high demand and success of our April shredding event, we will be implementing residency checks at future events to ensure our residents continue to benefit from this valuable service.

Residents are limited to three medium sized boxes/bags.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL WASTE DISPOSAL

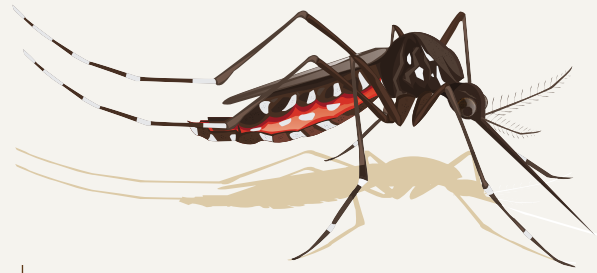

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT

As the weather gets warmer, the emergence of pesky mosquitos begins. Unfortunately, mosquitos are not only a pest but a carrier of disease (West Nile Virus). To help eliminate this on-going threat Vernon Township has a contract with Clarke Mosquito Control to treat known breeding areas in unincorporated Vernon Township. The treatment program is conducted periodically from May through September. **For further information regarding this program contact the Mosquito Hotline 1-800-942-2555.**

What can you do to control the mosquito population on your property?

Mosquitoes breed in standing water, it takes only a few days to produce a whole new generation of pests. Empty any outside containers that hold water: bird baths, potted plant trays, kid's wading pools, gutters.

Assessor's Update

Lake County Property Tax bills were mailed May 1st and should have been received by now. The bill is payable in two equal installments. The first due date is June 5 and the second installment is due September 5. Please note, Lake County residents receive a single tax bill for both installments.

Property owners who DO NOT receive a bill, or those looking for payment options, contact the Lake County Treasurer's Office at (847) 377-2323.

Payment options

Payments can be mailed to Lake County Treasurer's Office 18 N. County St., Waukegan, 60085. The Treasurer's Office accepts payments online by credit card or e-Check. The e-Check payment option is free and easy. Additionally, many local banks accept tax payments.

The bills are for 2023 property taxes, which are payable in 2024. Keep in mind, tax bills are based on the assessment of your property that took place last year and the appeal process has already passed.

By law, only factual errors can be corrected once the bills go out, changes cannot be made for market valuation issues.

Check your Exemptions!

Exemptions reduce taxes. An exemption reduces the taxable value of your home. The most common exemptions are: General Homestead, Senior Homestead, Senior Assessment Freeze and Home Improvement Exemption. On the bottom right side of the tax bills is the computation ladder. Look for the deductions applied in this area. Please contact my office if you believe you are missing an exemption.

Office is Open

Stevenson Student Metra Parking

for 2024/2025 School Year

Due to an agreement with Metra, Stevenson Students may purchase parking at the Prairie View Train Station. Stevenson students are to park ONLY in the East Parking Lot (the lot closest to Stevenson) off of Prairie Road.

We offer School Year, Half Year (Aug-Dec & Jan-May), and Monthly permits for Stevenson Students. The purchase of a Half Year permit includes a savings of one free month of parking, and the purchase of a Full Year permit includes a savings of two months of free parking.

Permit applications are available online at www.vernontownship.com on the Prairie View Metra Station page under the Community Tab. The application will be towards the bottom of the page. Please make sure you are applying for the correct permit, as there are separate permits available for Metra Commuters and applying for the wrong permit will delay the processing of your application.

After you submit the application, a township representative will send an e-mail notating its receipt and your next steps. Parking spaces are assigned on a first-come first-served basis. You are not able to choose your own parking space. Additionally, it is not guaranteed that there will always be parking permits available for purchase depending on demand.

Prices for the 2024/2025 school year are below and will be available for purchase beginning Monday, July 15th, 2024. Check, cash or credit/debit card payments are accepted, but Vernon Township cannot take credit or debit card payment over the phone. Additionally, there is a 3% convenience fee for using credit or debit cards.

There are also daily parking spaces available on the north end of the East lot for \$1.75 per day. Daily rates can be paid by either cash or credit card at the kiosk located at the corner of Rt 22/Half Day Road and Prairie Road. Students may also pay through the ParkMobile app for smartphones, or by calling 877-727-5004. The Prairie View Metra Station is referenced as Zone 831 for both services.
