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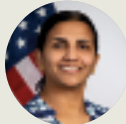

Highway Department Update

SUMMER PROJECTS

Spring and Summer is a busy time for the Highway Department. We will have multiple projects beginning in early spring and continuing through the fall. These projects fall into three main categories: Roadside maintenance, sealing of cracks in some roads, and total resurfacing in others.

Roadside Maintenance consists of replacing various driveway and road culverts, tree trimming, cutting grass, and intermittent ditch work that will happen across the unincorporated areas of Vernon Township.

Crack sealing will occur along the following streets: Apple Hill Ln., Arlyd Rd., Depot Pl., Woodbine Cir., Frank Ave., Garden Ct., Juneway Ave., Lita Ave., Ash St., Aspen Ct., Birch St., Catalpa St., Dogwood St., Maple Ct., Pekara Dr., and Walnut Dr.

Street resurfacing will occur on the following streets: Celia Ave., Margaret Ave., Eugene Ave., Clarice Ave., Horatio Blvd., Elizabeth Ave., William Ave., and Florence Ave. This may result in some street closures during the project, so please remain aware of traffic patterns.

VITAL DITCH MAINTENANCE

Where there are no storm sewers to drain away rain and melting snow, there are ditches and culverts. Culverts, which are corrugated plastic drainage pipes under driveway entrances, create a ditch system's free flowing continuity.

Carried by ditches and through culverts, precipitation runoff eventually finds its way to streams and then to rivers. However, if ditches are not kept clear of accumulated debris, including leaves and roadside litter, the runoff can become blocked and local flooding can occur.

You can help keep the ditch and culvert in front of your property from becoming blocked by periodically checking to make sure that water flow will not be impeded and not dumping grass, leaves, or any other type of debris in the ditch. If it appears blocked, water pressure from a garden hose will clear it. You should then clean up the debris and dispose of it properly.



NPDES PHASE II

In urbanized areas there are greater amounts of impervious surfaces such as streets, sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots that common pollutants such as pesticides, fertilizers, salt, oil, litter, and other debris can settle. The pollutants remain there until a storm event washes them away into nearby storm drains and are discharged untreated to waterways.

In response to this, as of March of 2003, the municipalities of Lake County were required to have a permit for Phase II of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's National Pollution Detection Elimination System (NPDES). Phase II is intended to reduce the negative impact to water quality and aquatic habitat by controlling unregulated sources of storm water discharge.

The municipalities are to implement a stormwater management program, which addresses 6 minimum control measures: public education, public participation, construction site runoff, post construction site runoff, detection of illicit discharge, and municipal pollution prevention. As part of Lake County, Vernon Township has the benefit of the Stormwater Management Commission (SMC). SMC has formed an ad-hoc Municipal Advisory Committee (MAC) that consists of representatives from villages, townships, drainage districts, consultants, and the county. Through this committee SMC coordinates the local program, provides technical assistance and outreach services. Because of the countywide activities of SMC, including the Watershed Development Ordinance (WDO), 4 of the 6 control measures are already in place.

This is an onsite shredding event, however if the truck fills up, there will be locked containers on site where you will be able to safely put your documents. Shredding services will be provided by Opportunity Secure Data Destruction.

SPRING CLEAN UP WEEKEND

Residents of unincorporated Vernon Township will be able to drop off unwanted household items at the Vernon Township Highway Department garage (3050 N Main St., Buffalo Grove) on Saturday, May 3rd and Sunday May 4th from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Unfortunately, there are some items that cannot be disposed of into our dumpsters, such as:

- Electronics/Appliances of any kind
- Mattresses
- Medications
- Tires
- Paint, solvents, household hazardous materials or chemicals
- Yard waste (grass clippings, brush or tree limbs)
- Construction debris

PERMITS

If you live in Unincorporated Vernon Township and you plan to perform any work in the right of way in front of your property, a permit is required from Vernon Township Highway Department. The right of way is defined as the area from your property line to the edge of the road. For most homes, this area is approximately 15 feet. Work that would require a permit includes but is not limited to: mailboxes, plantings, culvert-ditch maintenance, and driveway replacement.

Resident Assistance Programs

BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM (BAP)

Receive a discount on your license plate renewal sticker and a Ride Free RTA card.

The Illinois Department on Aging, along with the Illinois Secretary of State and the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA), created the program for income-eligible seniors 65+ and persons with disabilities.

REDUCED RTA FARES

The RTA, CTA, Metra, and Pace offer various programs that assist qualified riders in lowering their cost to ride local transit. Reduced fares are available to all seniors 65+ and people with disabilities.

SENIOR HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (SHIP)

Thinking of retiring or turning 65 in 2025?

Vernon Township is a host site for the Illinois Department on Aging Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP). SHIP is a national program that provides FREE counseling and information on the following Medicare programs: Enrollment, Prescription drug plans, Supplemental plans, Subsidies to offset the cost of Medicare, Claims, and Appeals.

SHIP representatives are trained counselors who provide counseling and are not affiliated with any insurance company.

Meet Our SHIP Counselor Jane Smith!

In the last 9 years, if you turned 65, retired, needed to understand the Medicare program, enroll in Medicare or appeal a Medicare decision, chances are that you were assisted by our volunteer SHIP (Senior Health Insurance Program) counselor at Vernon Township, Jane Smith. Jane was trained and certified as an Illinois SHIP counselor in 2013 and volunteered as a Medicare counselor at the Senior Center in Lake Forest and the Patti Turner Center in Deerfield, before bringing her services to Vernon Township in 2015.

Jane and her husband, Larry, have been residents of Vernon Hills since 1983, when she began a new job as a biochemist with Abbott that turned into a 30-year career from which she retired in 2013. She has a Ph.D. in biochemistry with postdoctoral training in Clinical Chemistry. The move to Vernon Hills gave her husband the opportunity to study law at Chicago Kent Law School. After graduating and passing the Illinois Bar, he joined Prairie State Legal Services and ultimately became managing attorney at the Waukegan and McHenry offices for a number of years before his retirement in 2014. Jane and Larry raised two children in Vernon Hills, both graduating from Stevenson High School - a son,

Britton, now an associate professor of Astrophysics at the University of Edinburgh in Scotland, and a daughter, Breland, who has a Ph.D. in Biochemistry and lives in South Carolina where she works remotely as Director of Clinical Affairs for a small reference lab with sites in Ireland and California. Both are married and have provided Jane and Larry with three fabulous grandchildren.

Since her retirement, Jane has been an active volunteer, serving her community in various capacities - first as a gardener at the Brushwood estate of Ryerson Woods, then as an AARP Tax Aide. She currently supports the Tenth Congressional District Democrats as their Finance Manager and is also President of her residential HOA Board.

For the past several years, despite spending the winter in South Carolina spoiling their two granddaughters, Jane has continued to provide Medicare counseling services to residents of the Vernon Township area via phone and zoom.

Stevenson Student Metra Station Parking for 2025/2026 School Year

Due to an agreement with Metra, Stevenson Students may purchase parking at the Prairie View Train Station. Stevenson students are to park ONLY in the East Parking Lot (the lot closest to Stevenson) off of Prairie Road.

We offer School Year, Half Year (Aug-Dec & Jan-May), and Monthly permits for Stevenson Students. The purchase of a Half Year permit includes one month of parking free, and the purchase of a Full Year permit includes two months free.

Permit applications are available online at www.vernontownship.com on the Prairie View Metra Station page under the Community Tab. The application will be towards the bottom of the page. Please make sure you are applying for the correct permit, as there are separate permits available for Metra Commuters and applying for the wrong permit will delay the processing of your application.

After you submit the application, a township representative will send an e-mail notating its receipt and your next steps. As of this school year, parking spaces are no longer assigned. Students with a permit may park in any available spot in the East Parking Lot. It is not guaranteed that there will always be parking permits available for purchase depending on demand.

Prices for the 2025/2026 school year are below and will be available for purchase beginning Monday, July 14th, 2025. Check, cash or credit/debit card payments are accepted, but Vernon Township cannot take credit or debit card payment over the phone or online. There is a 3% convenience fee for using credit or debit cards.

There are also daily parking spaces available in the East lot for \$1.75 per day. You must pay for the correct parking space to avoid potential ticketing for unpaid parking. Daily rates can be paid by either cash or credit card at the kiosk located at the corner of Rt 22/Half Day Road and Prairie Road. Students may also pay through the ParkMobile app for smartphones, or by calling 877-727-5004. The Prairie View Metra Station is referenced as Zone 831 for both of these services.
