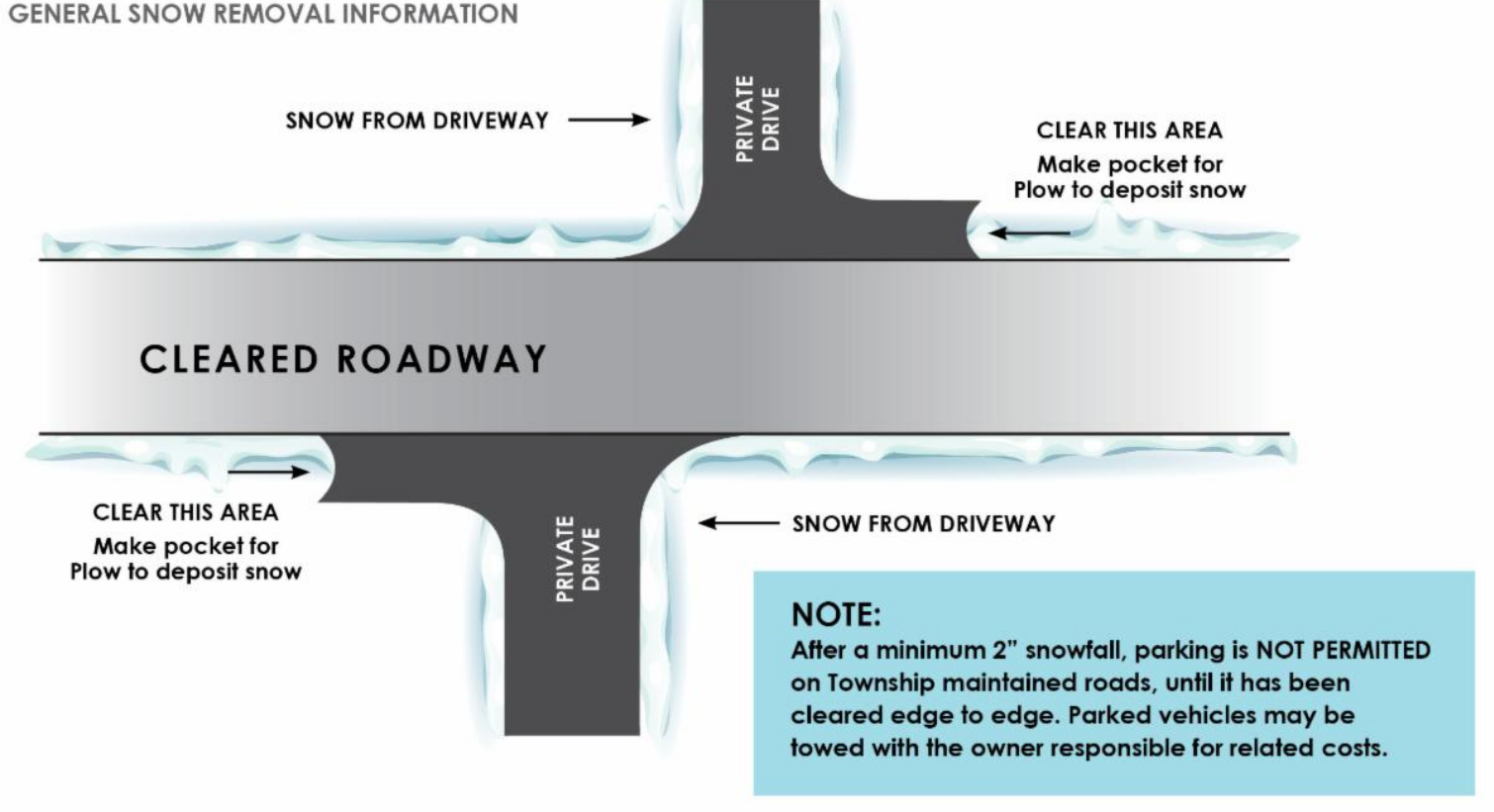

Snow Removal Information

GENERAL SNOW REMOVAL INFORMATION



Vernon Township would like to remind residents to avoid placing garbage receptacles on, or near the road during snow removal, because snow plows may damage them. When shoveling your driveway, please remember to pile snow in the direction of traffic and create a pocket on the opposite side to reduce snow from plows blocking the driveway. Also, keep driveway snow mounds low for visibility and ensure no snow or ice is pushed onto roadways, per Illinois law ([605 ILCS 5/9-130](#)). Clear areas around mailboxes and fire hydrants, and remove decorative objects at least six feet from the road to prevent damage to vehicles and plows. 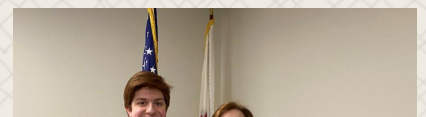
