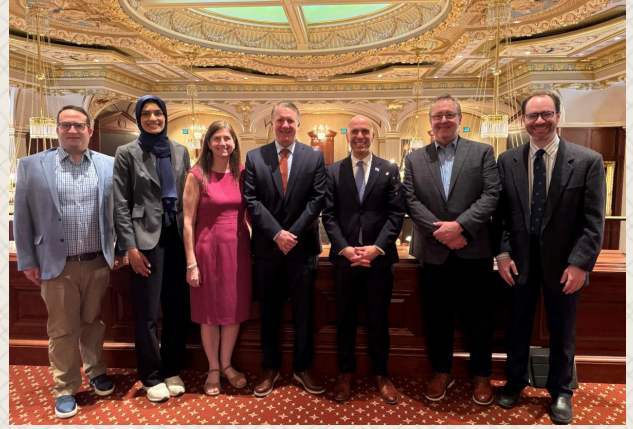
Metropolitan Township Association Capitol Day
