Register Now for Summer Camps!



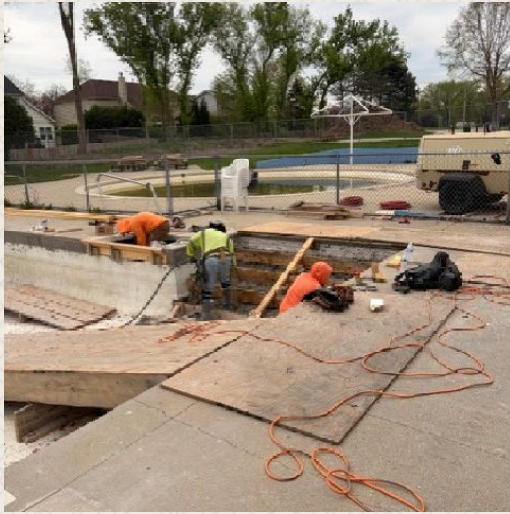
